PARKOUR SCHOLARSHIPS

Coach Tristan has 5 years of parkour training. Tristan has a way of connecting with kids of all ages. He is patient in his approach and firm to ensure the kids' safety as they learn parkour.

Over 50% of the youth in our parkour classes and camps are considered "at risk" by the local school districts. Parkour teaches all kids how to use their body safely and creatively. Giving kids an outlet helps to keep them out of trouble and keeps their bodies healthy!

While initially it would appear that teaching parkour doesn't cost anything we always have to take into account the cost to pay for our insurance (which is necessary but astronomical) to ensure our coverage for parkour classes and events as well as maintaining + replacing our equipment.
